Introduction

VeriGuide Moodle is a Moodle module which help users to facilitate VeriGuide services in your own Moodle System.

Preparation

To begin, you require the following:

- 1. A VeriGuide Academic Account (Refer to Chapter 2: VeriGuide Academic Account)
- 2. VeriGuide Plagiarism Prevention module source code (Refer to Chapter 3: Installation)
- 3. API Address, School ID and School API Key (Refer to Chapter 4: Configuration)

Besides, this Moodle module requires Moodle 2.3.x . Please check your running Moodle version. For upgrading your Moodle, please visit <u>Moodle.org</u> for details.





Chapter 2: VeriGuide Account

Chapter 3: Installation

VeriGuide Plagiarism Prevention Module

The VeriGuide Plagiarism Prevention module should contains the following 11 files in the zip archive:

- veriguide/db/access.php
- veriguide/db/events.php
- veriguide/db/install.xml
- veriguide/lang/en/plagiarism_veriguide.php
- veriguide/lib.php
- veriguide/README
- veriguide/settings.php
- veriguide/styles.css
- veriguide/veriguide_form.php
- veriguide/veriguide_tabs.php
- veriguide/version.php

Installation

Extract the zip archive and copy all the contents and paste them in plagiarism folder under your root moodle directory.

Login your moodle with administrator role and click "Notification" under the "Site Administration" block.



It will install the VeriGuide Plagiarism Prevention module automatically, i.e. adding 3 database tables.

VeriGuide Plagiarism Prevention Configuration

After the installation. First, go to "Site Administration" -> "Advanced features", ensure "Enable plagiarism plugins" setting is enabled. Then, please go to "Site Administration" -> "Plugins" -> "Plagiarism prevention" -> "VeriGuide" for the configuration.

I. Account Information

Enter your API address, School ID and School API Key provided upon purchase. The API address should be a internet link to the VeriGuide Moodle Listener interface. The school ID should be a number and the school API key should consists of 36 character (32 digits and 4 hyphens). You will need to choose the user authentication method.

There are 2 user authentication methods available, email and LDAP. Please refer to "User Account" in "Chapter 2: VeriGuide Academic Account".

II. Functional Configuration

1. Enable identity masking

You can enable the identity masking on student's submissions.

- 2. Enable student email receipt Enable sending the email notification to student when he/she submit a assignment.
- 3. Enable teacher customize setting Enable teacher can customize the VeriGuide assignment setting when they create.
- 4. Student Disclosure

Disclosure paste on the assignment submission page.

5. VeriGuide Default Parameters

Set up the default setting on each assignment. If "Enable teacher customize setting" is enabled, teacher can change the settings.

- There are 6 settings:
- A. Enable other TA view

By enabling this option, all the TAs in this course can view all report in this assignment.

B. Enable student view similarity percentage

By enabling this option, students in this course can view their own report similarity percentage in this assignment.

C. Enable student view detailed report

By enabling this option, students in this course can view their own detailed report in this assignment.

D. Minimum sentence length

Only sentence with length longer than minimum sentence length will be consider in similarity text processing, shorter sentences will be ignored.

E. Leniency

The leniency in this assignment.

F. Enable teacher email notification

By enabling this option, teachers created this assignment will receive a email notification after 7 days from the assignment deadline.





SMTP Configuration

Make sure your Moodle SMTP is configured properly. Go to "Server" -> "Email" and enter the corresponding settings:

- SMTP hosts
- SMTP security
- SMTP username
- SMTP password
- No-reply address
